Stages of a Frog's Life

Eggs (Frogspawn) are tiny and laid by the thousands.

Tadpoles hatch from the eggs and live in the water. They use gills to breathe.

Tadpoles begin to develop legs. They still live and breathe in the water.

Froglets are almost mature and still have a tail, but now breath with lungs.

Adult frogs have no tails (the tail is absorbed into the body) and continue to breathe with lungs.
